## **Test Methods**

Test Species: Brown garden snail, Helix aspersa

Treatment Application Date: March 1, 2011

Evaluation Interval: 1, 3, 7, 14 DAT (days after treatment)

Test Description: Field trial, randomized complete block design. Treatments consisted of 3 snails per  $1.78 \text{ ft}^2$  caged plot in citrus, 3 cages per rep  $\times$  4 replicates/treatment. Bait was applied once by hand.

**Conclusion:** Bug-N-Sluggo is more effective than two standard snail baits.
