

Frequently Asked Questions

What is Fiesta Granular Weed & Feed?

Fiesta Granular Weed & Feed is a ready-to-use combination of fertilizer with a pre-emergent and post-emergent herbicide

What are the benefits of Fiesta Granular Weed & Feed?

Six benefits in one application! Fiesta Granular Weed & Feed is an EPA-approved low-risk product that fertilizes your turf while providing pre- and post-emergent control of broadleaf weeds and smooth crabgrass as well as postemergent control of moss, algae, and diseases commonly found in turf. Fiesta Weed & Feed is ideal for counties with pesticide restrictions or bans (check your local county allowances).

How does Fiesta kill weeds and crabgrass?

Iron phytotoxicity - Fiesta Granular Weed & Feed affects broadleaf plants and crabgrass more strongly than it does turfgrass

What is the rate and timing for preemergent applications?

Begin application when soil temperatures reach 50 °F to 55 °F. Apply 5 - 8 lbs./1000 sq. ft., depending on weed pressure. Repeat treatment in 3 to 6 weeks for best results.

What is the rate and timing for postemergent applications?

For best results, apply when weeds are young and actively growing at a rate of 3 - 8 lbs./1000 sq. ft. (The standard rate for this product is 5 lbs./1000 sq. ft.; use the higher rate of 8 lbs./1000 sq. ft. on tough perennial weeds.)

What is the Guaranteed Analysis of the fertilizer component?

Total nitrogen (N) – 8.0%; Soluble Potash (K2O) - 1.0%; Iron (Fe), water-soluble - 1.8%

What are the spreader settings?

Please refer to the label for spreader settings of the most common spreaders (Scotts broadcast and rotary spreader, Scotts drop spreader, and Scotts hand-held spreader)

Does the turfgrass need to be wet prior to application?

If the temperature is below 80 °F, ensure turf is wet from dew, or water turf lightly before application. If temperature is above 80 °F, do not pre-wet grass and apply product in the late afternoon or evening.

What is the temperature range that Fiesta Granular Weed & Feed should be applied?

For best results, apply a few days after mowing when temperature is between 50 °F and 85 °F. If temperature is below 80 °F, ensure turf is wet from dew, or water turf lightly before application. If temperature is above 80 °F, do not pre-wet grass and apply product in the late afternoon or evening.

What are the package sizes available?

20 lb. bags and 40 lb. bags

What is the coverage?

A 20 lb. bag will cover up to 6,667 sq.ft. A 40 lb. bag will cover up to 13,330 sq.ft. at the 3 lb./1000 sq. ft. rate

How soon will I see dead weeds?

You will begin to see treated weeds, moss, or algae turn brown or black within 24 hours of application

Will Fiesta Granular Weed & Feed affect the color of turf?

Occasionally, the grass leaf blades can darken after treatment; however, the grass will recover within a few days. Sweep or blow product back into turf to avoid staining of hard surfaces.
